Limno-Explorers: Discovering the World of Water

Have fun while learning this summer!

Children explore the hills, valleys, ponds, and streams of our 2,000-acre campus. During each session campers conduct mini-scientific investigations, learn about local natural history, and participate in team building activities. This year campers will be introduced to the complexities of the water cycle, the concept of watersheds, and become familiar with the plants and animals that make aquatic ecosystems their home.

Weekly sessions are limited to a maximum of 12 campers and are dedicated to either younger campers (grades 2-4) or older campers (grades 5-7). Register on-line, by mail, or by phone.
